Ringwould with Kingsdown Parish Council

The Council held its Annual General Meeting on 10th May, and Cllr Sarah Wilson was elected Chairman and Cllr Nick Fish was elected Vice-Chairman.

A number of issues were considered at the meeting – access to Popples Farm, unlawful access by vehicles to Freedown Woods, the purchase of more dog pooh bins, improving the surface of No Name Road, and the relocation of the Council's notice board in Ringwould.

Councillors also agreed to set up a Facebook page to assist in communicating with residents.

The sale by auction of the Ministry of Defence's former firing range at Undercliffe resulted in a meeting between representatives of the Parish Council, Kingsdown Conservation Group and the Kent Wildlife Trust to consider the options for protecting the area and its wildlife. The principal problem is the lack of information about the liabilities of any owner for the coastal defences.

The Council held a two-centre All Parish Meeting on 1st June – one at Kingsdown Village Hall and the other at Ringwould Village Hall – to allow for Covid secure meetings. Though both were not as well attended as hoped, there was useful feedback from members of the public, and the Council launched a questionnaire regarding the future of the firing range.

A room at the rear of Ringwould Village Hall has been rented by the Parish Council to act as a Council office. It is currently being fitted out with the intention of having a presence in the parish at least one day a week.

A great deal of work has been going on behind the scenes to provide a solid foundation for the Council's activities, but there are still vacancies for councillors. If you would like to learn more about your community and how you can help it flourish, you can apply to be a co-opted councillor – just let the Clerk know that you are interested and she will let you know how to go about it.



Annual Parish Meeting - The Annual Parish meeting was held at 7.00 pm. The Chair, Barbara Merriman gave her report of the activities carried out by the Council during the year. A copy of this is available with the minutes of the meeting on the parish council website. There were no questions from members of the public.

AGM - The AGM was held at 7.20pm. Barbara Merriman was elected as Chair for the coming year and Graeme Akhurst was appointed as Vice Chair. All councillors agreed to continue with their responsibilities from the previous year although they decided to share between them the responsibility for planning for this year.

Ordinary Monthly meeting

Planning - The Councillors considered three planning applications. The Council listened to and discussed the concerns of local residents regarding the application for the airstrip at Manor Farm, Little Mongeham. The Councillors listed several reasons opposing the change of use of the land to a runway and decided to object to the planning application. The planning log is up and running on the website for parishioners to check local applications.

Playing field - The new bin has been installed. Thanks to Doug Vickers for this.

Allotments/Orchard - The risk assessment for the community event particularly with regard to bees on the site was discussed. To be revisited at the next meeting.

Orchard Community Event - The pencilled in date for this is Sunday 11th July 2021. Arrangements for the event were discussed. The plan is to invite residents to bring their own picnic to the orchard to enjoy the surroundings and allotment holders to be invited along to show and talk about the produce they are growing on their plots. To be discussed again at the June meeting.

Coronavirus Memorial - The Councillors supported the Church's suggestion to arrange a memorial and short service for those local residents affected by the Coronavirus pandemic. Other parties to be approached for their approval.

Litter Pick - To go on the June agenda when the councillors can hold a face to face meeting.

These individual resolutions were agreed 'en bloc' by an all encompassing resolution.

Chairman's Report: Under present legislation this is our last Zoom meeting of the full council.

Staff are now back working in the office which will be open to the public from nine until one every day.

A letter was received from a resident who claimed that this council was corrupt and undemocratic. The resident was spoken to on the telephone, and they now realise that it was another council.

On a happier note, this is the first meeting to be clerked by Richard Styles, until last week Town clerk of Ramsgate. A resident of Walmer, Richard, has spent many years in local government on both sides of the fence including a spell as a Kent County Council member. Before that he was a seagoing engineer specialising in steam engines and is a volunteer for a local railway preservation group. The Chairman welcomed Richard and repeated thanks to the now retired - and relieved - acting clerk Cllr Mrs Sue Le Chevalier for the sterling work she did keeping the ship not only afloat but on its proper course.



Dear Residents, May we first apologise for not providing you with an update over the past two months. Due to the local elections we were constrained by the rules around what we can say during a campaign and therefore decided to make no comment during that period.

Now that we are back to normal we will start with the news that Ollie was duly elected as the KCC representative for Dover Town. Well done, Ollie! The DDC Council AGM saw him also retain his position as portfolio holder for Community, Environment and Corporate Property whilst Martin has moved to lead member for Housing.

Parish Councils resumed meeting in halls throughout the ward from 7th May and many kicked off with their annual meetings. There are continuing concerns around the parking of motor homes and the accumulation of rubbish along Kingsdown seafront. Both Ollie, Martin and the parish council are continuing to work with DDC and KCC to see how we can mitigate the situation as much as possible.

We were all tested when Veolia changed its rubbish collection schedule on 12th April and reduced its collection rounds from five to three. New vehicles were introduced, and rounds were reconfigured to take account of the additional housing which had been created in the District since the last review. The idea being to reduce congestion and other environmental impacts. Unfortunately, the introduction culminated in numerous delays to rubbish collection and our inboxes piled up with numerous complaints from frustrated residents. This resulted in discussions between ourselves and DDC officers who were similarly talking to Veolia to try and resolve the situation as soon as possible. During the May Day holiday the company drafted in additional resources from other areas of the country and managed to catch up with the backlog. Veolia has issued an apology and will react quickly to any customers still experiencing problems.


As we now enter the Summer DDC continues to work on a number of projects to improve our infrastructure and tourist facilities within the area. The Dover Fast Track project linking Dover with the Whitfield Urban development is on track to complete construction by June 2023 and news is still awaited concerning the decision to develop an Internal Border Facility at White Cliffs Business Park.

The improvements at Kearsney Abbey and Russell Gardens have transformed the area with the café due to open soon. Work has also commenced to provide a range of facilities at Maison Dieu and work will soon commence for the rejuvenation of Market Square.

COVID remains with us unfortunately but the vaccination programme, along with lockdown reduced cases to such an extent that we could confidently move ahead with the relaxation of restrictions on 17th May. However, we cannot afford to be complacent as there are indications of a rise in infections in certain areas of the country. So be careful and stay safe.


