ORDER 2021

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL under sections 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 3 (2), 4 (1) and (2), 32 (1), 35 (1), 44, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby proposes to make the following order:-

The effect of the Order will be to introduce new or to extend or amend existing waiting restrictions in the following lengths of road (in this part of the notice DYL means waiting to be prohibited at all times by double yellow lines at the times prescribed below).

Roads in Deal in the District of Dover

CROSS ROAD, DEAL — DYL - (1) On both sides of the junction extend the current lines to 20 metres in a southerly direction. (2) On the east side from a point 3 metres south of the boundary of 63/65 Cross Road for a distance of 16 metres in a northerly direction. (3) On the west side from a point in line with the southern boundary of 60 Cross Road for a distance of 24.5 metres in a northerly direction. ST RICHARDS ROAD, DEAL — DYL — On the south west side extend the current lines by 27 metres outside 91/93 St Richards Road. STATION ROAD, DEAL — DYL — (1) On the north side from its junction with Sydney Road for a distance of 96 metres in a north westerly direction. (2) On the south west side extend the current lines by 11 metres outside 85/87a Station Road. (3) On the south side from a point 10 metres north west of the western boundary of 107 Station Road for a distance of 139 meters in a north westerly direction.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53, 122 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby propose to make the following Order:-

Revocations, Modifications and Amendments

In this Order the expression "Order of 2005" means "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2005". The Order of 2005 shall have effect as though:

In the Schedule to the Order of 2005

Roads in Deal in the District of Dover

The following to be inserted in the First Schedule of the Order of 2005 in place of the existing entries:-

CROSS ROAD

- (1) On both sides from its junction with St Richards Road for a distance of 20 metres in a southerly direction.
- (2) On the east side
- (a) from a point in line with the property boundary of Nos 36/38 for a distance of 85 metres in a northerly direction;
- (b) of the road from a point 2.3 metres south of the boundary of no.9 and no.11 for a distance of 20 metres in a southerly direction to a point located 4.2 metres south of the boundary on no.11 and no.15;
- (c) from a point 3 metres south of the boundary of 63/65 Cross Road for a distance of 16 metres in a northerly direction.
- (3) On the west side
- (a) from its junction with Manor View to a point 53 metres north and to a point 23 metres south;
- (b) of the road from a point 5.7 metres south of the northern boundary wall of no.22 for a distance of 20 metres in a northerly direction to a point located 4.3 metres south of the boundary of no.16 and no.18;
- (c) from a point in line with the southern boundary of 60 Cross Road for a distance of 24.5 metres in a northerly direction.

The following to be inserted in the First Schedule of the Order of 2005 in place of the existing entries:-

ST RICHARDS ROAD

- (1) On the south west side
- (a) from a point 29 metres south east of the centre line of Sydney Road north westwards for a distance of 44 metres;
- (b) from the junction with Cross Road to a point 34 metres south east and to a point 10 metres north west;
- (c) from a point opposite the party wall of Nos.388 and 390 north westwards to a point in line with the boundary of Nos. 409 and 411;
- (d) from its junction with Mongeham Road for a distance of 24 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- (2) On the north east side
- (a) from a point opposite the south eastern boundary of no.103 St Richards Road northwest wards for a distance of 13 metres;
- (b) from its junction with Mongeham Road for a distance of 15 metres in a south-easterly direction.

The following to be inserted in the First Schedule of the Order of 2005 in place of the existing entries:-

STATION ROAD

- (1) On the northern side
- (a) from a point opposite and in line with the boundary between Nos.81/83 Station Road north westerly direction for a distance of 46 meters.
- (b) from its junction with Dover Road in a westerly direction to a point in line with the boundary between Nos.6/8 Station Road;
- (c) from its junction with Sydney Road for a distance of 96 metres in a north westerly direction.
- (2) On the southern side
- (a) from a point in line with the boundary between Nos.81/83 Station Road north westerly direction for a distance of 52 meters.
- (b) from its junction with Dover Road in a westerly direction to a point in line with the eastern boundary of No.9 Station Road;
- (c) from a point 10 metres north west of the western boundary of 107 Station Road for a distance of 139 metres in a north westerly direction.

This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No.93) Order 2021" ('this Order') and shall come into operation on the day of 2021.
