Notes from the meeting held on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> September 2021

The meeting was held in Sutton Community Centre and was attended by four members of the public

*Local Community. The defibrillator.* This was discussed, further enquiries to be made into having it serviced.

*Bus shelter.* It was decided to bring to a close, the use of the bus shelter as a book store as it has become overrun and concerns were voiced that with bad weather perhaps just around the corner, no room was being left to use the shelter for its proper purpose.

*Notice board.* The Council decided to relocate the notice board from the Church Hall hedge to a location more easily accessible to everyone. It is therefore going to be moved to the bus shelter. A local resident kindly offered to do this for the council.

*New bin.* Enquiries are to be made from DDC regarding the cost of having a new bin emptied if the parish council were to purchase and install one in Ashley near the footpath entrance onto the road.

*Electric charging bays.* The Community Centre's application to install two charging bays in the car park of the community hall was fully supported by the Parish Council on the understanding that there is no financial commitment.

*Planning.* The Councillors considered one planning application. The planning log is up and running on the website for parishioners to check local applications. Various decisions from DDC were noted at the meeting.

The Council also discussed again the consultation on the parish settlement confines. The Council decided to support all three of the proposed areas in the parish.

*Playing field: Dog waste bin.* The Council are looking into replacing the old, broken bin with a new one. Further enquiries to be made.

*Rospa.* The Council discussed the recent report. There had been very few comments made on any safety problems. A few minor issues were discussed and solutions agreed.

Allotments: The plot sizes and costs were clarified for next year's rental agreements. Another application has bee made for a plot which brings the

number of people on the waiting list to three.

*Correspondence:* The Councillors agreed that the KCC consultation on the household waste recycling centre booking system should go on the website.

The next ordinary meeting is on **Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> October 2021** 7.30pm at Sutton Parish Community Centre

**Change of style...**The Council agreed to change the style of the Council from Walmer Parish Council to Walmer Town Council with immediate effect, and that from now on any documents reading 'Walmer Parish Council', shall be taken, or read as saying 'Walmer Town Council'.

Chairman's report...Asst Clerk, Mrs Sarah Plews, has left WPC and the Chairman thanked her for her past work and commitment to the Council.

**Matters arising**...Thermal Imaging camera. The Council agreed to go ahead with the purchase of this instrument which will be used to help residents in Walmer see the extent of heat loss from their homes and businesses and potentially reduce their heating costs.

**Cllr Bond on DDC and KCC...matters.** To help with speeding in Station Road temporary traffic lights may be fitted at the junction of Station Road and Dover Road. These lights may act as a trial to something more permanent.

He suggested that WTC apply for some of his members' grant to help fund a speed camera.

Crime and anti-social behaviour reports...Cllr Weale as WPC's police liaison Cllr gave the following report.

Regretfully PCSO Adam Herod is leaving Deal/Walmer for Thanet.

A community speed watch group will need to be trained and equipped to increasing public awareness and cooperation in reducing speeds in Walmer

Work is going on to reduce anti-social behaviour in various parts of Walmer and the details will go on the website.

**Financial report...**The clerk and the Chairman of the F+GP Committee will review all current council contracts and make sure they are fit for purpose.

Cllr internal auditor appointments would be reviewed at the next F+GP Comittee meeting.

**Invitations and events...**Deal Town Council 'Charter Day' – To be attended by Cllr Weale as Civic representative.

### Adaption/refurbishment of new council offices.

The report was in two parts current and future.

All works required to convert the building into Council offices are complete.

The Climate Emergency Working Group will issue a report on how work to reduce the carbon footprint and increase the building's resilience is progressing.

The Clerk was empowered to arrange a suitable CCTV system to cover the building front and rear.

**Review of Governance documents...** The Clerk had reviewed the Council Standing orders and found them fit for purpose and in conformity with the NALC model standing orders. His only recommendation was to reformat the standing orders without altering any wording, so that they can be more easily referenced.

### Unveiling of the Memorial Plaque at Walmer Station

The unveiling of the Memorial plaque to four African-American soldiers killed at Walmer Station at the end of the Second World War was the culmination of two years of research by local historians Colin Varrall, David Chamberlain, Carly Morris and Phil Eyden. Phil explains how it came about:

"I was reading an online copy of the Dover Express and by chance caught sight of a short

article published in September 1945. This stated there had been a petrol tanker explosion at Walmer Station and a number of African-American soldiers had been killed. This intrigued me as I asked around online and no-one knew any details about it.

"We decided that that we would try to research it as we wished to know more about the circumstances and their names. After contacting the American Battle Monuments Commission, we were sent a list of US servicemen killed on the 12<sup>th</sup> September. I noted that four of them had the same unit, the 509th Port Battalion and cross-checking with an American newspaper revealed that this unit was stationed at Oxney after VE Day. I realised we had the right men."

It transpired that the explosion was directly linked to an earlier disaster, that of the Liberty Ship the SS James Harrod which had caught fire following a collision in the Downs with another ship back on the 16th January with the loss of four men. Loaded with ammunition, petrol and vehicles bound for Antwerp, the blazing wreck was towed to Deal where it became grounded a few hundred yards off- shore near Deal pier.

The 509th Port Battalion were then brought to Oxney to assist in offloading the ship after VE Day. On the fateful evening of the 12th September they were pouring jerrycans retrieved from the wreck into a tanker wagon when a spark ignited the petrol vapour causing a huge explosion. Four men were killed instantly, and nine more were badly injured.

A couple of days later, the men were given a memorial service at Deal Barracks, two were buried in England (Cambridge) and two were repatriated back to their hometowns in the US.

The group decided to commemorate the men by erecting a plaque at the station. Via public crowdfunding and grants from Southeastern Railways, Walmer Town Council, Deal and Walmer Lions and the US Legion, enough was raised for the plaque which was unveiled at the ceremony, on the 76<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. A booklet has also been produced explaining the two disasters which is available at Walmer Station with all the proceeds going to the Friends of Deal Hospital.

Those attending the ceremony:

Thanet Community Gospel Choir who sang the same songs that were sung at an original memorial service in 1945.

David Goodban (son of Leslie Goodban who was the Chief Fire Officer who tackled the blaze) unveiled the plaque.

Walmer residents Keith Shorten and Mary Gough who were eyewitnesses of the actual explosion.


Contrary to the appalling weather conditions we experienced in August, September has proved to be a bonus with some glorious weather throughout the month and we hope that you were able to take full advantage. We certainly did. Martin enjoyed a pleasant journey through our area on 11<sup>th</sup> September on a sponsored cycle ride for Ride and Stride whilst Ollie was able to take some belated leave with his family in Wales.

With the end of the summer DDC is now back to work with staff now able to spend an increasing amount of time in the office. Work has resumed on a number of capital projects. You have probably noticed the scaffolding appearing on Maison Dieu whilst the renovation programme gets into full swing and the archaeological work being undertaken in Dover Market Square in preparation for its redevelopment. Other initiatives also continued. The closing date for the Winter Community Grant Scheme was on 20<sup>th</sup> September and DDC have received 72 applications totalling £121,841.82. Details of successful applicants should be announced towards the end of October. The Great British Beach Clean took place as advertised in the previous newsletter and on 23<sup>rd</sup> September Martin joined the team down at Kingsdown seafront for a litter picking exercise.

The DDC Environmental Protection and Crime Unit have signed a three-year contract with a company called Waste Investigation Support and Enforcement (WISE). They will be responsible for patrolling the District and serving fixed penalty notices for litter dropping and failure to pick up dog waste. This will free up DDC staff to investigate other infringements such as fly-tipping. The new team will start operating from 18<sup>th</sup> October.

Waste collections have improved significantly over the past month with almost 100% of recycled, household and food waste collections taking place daily. Over the past few weeks, Veolia, have been able to recruit and retain HGV drivers. This has given them sufficient confidence to consider resuming the garden waste collection service. We have been advised that first garden waste collection service is planned for week commencing Monday 11th October 2021. Your collection day for the garden waste service remains the same as it was prior to the suspension. (If you need to check your collection day you can do so by visiting: https:// collections.dover.gov.uk/property (inputting your postcode and then choosing your property).) As usual they will accept up to 6 bags of garden waste on each collection cycle. If your garden waste bin is not collected on the scheduled day please leave it at your property boundary and they will collect it as soon as possible. The Council intends to offer a discount off the subscription for 2022/23 to all existing customers, and details will be confirmed later.

We both wish you a pleasant October as we commence our journey through the autumnal season. Keep well. *Councillors Martin and Ollie*




