Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Kent County Council, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers and under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 19, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 49, 51, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act'), the Traffic Management 2004 and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby propose to make the following Order:-

The effect of the named Order will introduce or amend double yellow lines (DYL) no waiting restrictions at any time on the following length of roads in Walmer, Dover:-

SALISBURY ROAD - DYL – On the north east side extend the existing double yellow lines from a point 6 metres west of its entrance to The Beacon School for a distance of 19 metres in a north westerly direction.
