#### Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL under sections 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 3 (2), 4 (1) and (2), 32 (1), 35 (1), 44, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following order:-

The effect of the Order will be to introduce new or to extend or amend existing waiting restrictions in the following lengths of road (in this part of the notice DYL means waiting to be prohibited at all times by double yellow lines at the times prescribed below).

#### Roads in Deal in the District of Dover

**STATION ROAD** - **DYL** – On the south side extend the DYL from the boundary of 9 Station Road in a westerly direction by 17.3 metres to join the existing DYL.

The Order was made on 17 June 2021 and its provisions will come into effect on 24 June 2021.

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.

The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53, 122 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

#### **Revocations, Modifications and Amendments**

In this Order the expression "Order of 2005" means "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2005". The Order of 2005 and shall have effect as though:

#### In the Schedule to the Order of 2005

#### SCHEDULE 1.00 NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

#### **Roads in Deal in the District of Dover**

The following entry to be inserted in the First Schedule of the Order of 2005 in place of the existing entries:--

- STATION ROAD (1) On both sides from points opposite and in line with the boundary between Nos.81/83 Station Road westwards for a distance of 46 metres.
  - (2) On the north side

(a) from its junction with Dover Road in a westerly direction to a point in line with the boundary between Nos. 6/8 Station Road;

(b) from its junction with Nevil Gardens to a point 11 metres east and to a point 11 metres west.

(3) On the south side from its junction with Dover Road in a westerly direction to a point 1.5 metres west of the western boundary of No.19 Station Road.


