207. WELCOME

Cllr James Murray, Chairman Walmer Parish Council welcomed everyone to the meeting.

208. MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY, 1st MAY 2019

The minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday, 1 May 2019 were approved as a correct record and signed by the Chairman. No meeting was held in 2020 due to Covid-19 restrictions.

209. REPORT OF THE CHAIRMAN

Cllr James Murray thanked everyone who makes up the Walmer Parish Council team for a successful year. He also welcomed all the new councillors and reported on some of the new projects which will be coming to fruition in 2021. Cllr Murray then gave the floor to the Cttee Chairs to give an outline of the work of the various Cttees:

- Finance+ General Purposes Cttee – Cllr Eddy.
- Amenities + Environment Cttee – Cllr Eddy (for Cllr Pitcher).

210. PRESENTATION OF KALC COMMUNITY AWARD TO FRED UPTON (2020) AND DR PAUL EDLIN (2021)

Cllr James Murray explained that the Kent Association of Local Councils invites Parish Councils to nominate local residents who have demonstrated an outstanding contribution to the Parish. This year Walmer Parish Council unanimously approved the nomination of Dr Paul Edlin in recognition of his work with both young and old in making music available and as we were unable to hold a Parish Meeting last year Fred Upton was nominated for an award in 2020 for his efforts over many years to improve the environment of Walmer for both residents and visitors by clearing litter left or washed up on Walmer beach and recycling it wherever possible.

Both were presented with a framed certificate and gave a short presentation.

211. FINANCE REPORT

The Clerk outlined the accounts for 2020/21, which had just been reconciled. The Clerk stated the accounts will have to be given an internal and external audit prior to publication. In the meantime, figures for income and expenditure were given to the meeting. The approved and audited accounts for 2021/22 will be available for inspection at the Parish Office, once the audit process has been completed.
